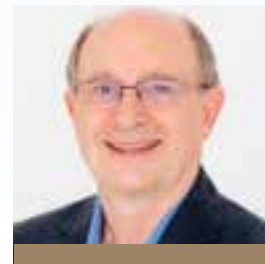

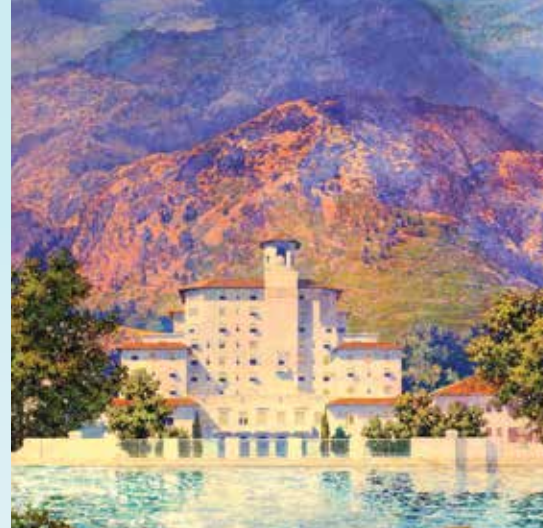

Colorado's Iconic Resort

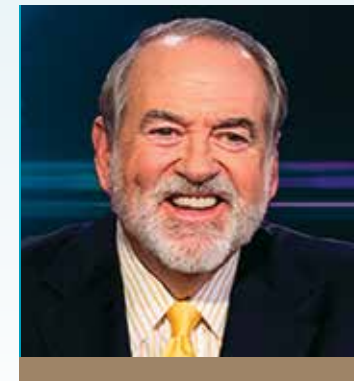
The Broadmoor is always mentioned in lists of the best resort hotels in America, usually at the very top. It has been a five-star/five-diamond property for more than 60 years in a row; you'll experience its legendary service that earned those ratings throughout the entire 5,000-acre property. Something else you'll experience is Wild West history. In many ways, The Broadmoor is an art and history museum with paintings, photos, clippings, and artifacts from bygone days. The legends you'll learn about those early railroad barons and yesterday's gold miners will be enthralling.

If you want to get outdoors, this vast facility has paved walkways around a lake that is the centerpiece of the property. Golfers, too, can walk to their hearts' delight over the two 18-hole championship courses (but electric carts are also available). If you want to get a bit further out, Seven Falls, a series of seven cascading waterfalls, is just minutes away. Referred to as "The Grandest Mile of Scenery in Colorado," the beautiful area features a mile-long walk to view the falls from the top of a 224-step staircase. Once above the scenic wonder, you can follow additional trails through the forest.

GOVERNOR MIKE HUCKABEE

The 44th governor of Arkansas and a Southern Baptist pastor noted for his evangelical views, Mike is the host of the talk show "Huckabee," which ran on the Fox News Channel from 2008 to 2015 and has aired on TBN since October 2017. He loves playing bass with his musical guests. His daughter Sarah is Arkansas's current governor.



DR. GEORGE BARNA

Author of 68 books, Dr. Barna is the director of research and cofounder of the Cultural Research Center at Arizona Christian University. George has conducted groundbreaking research on worldviews, cultural transformation, ministry applications, spiritual development, and elections. He has conducted more than 1,000 surveys, which involved interviewing more than one million Americans.

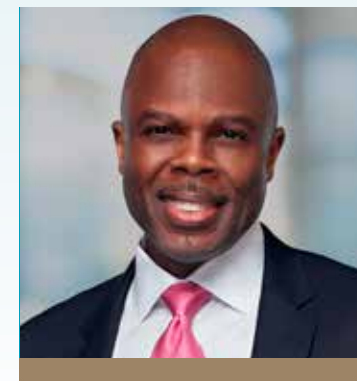
ADAM CHRISTING

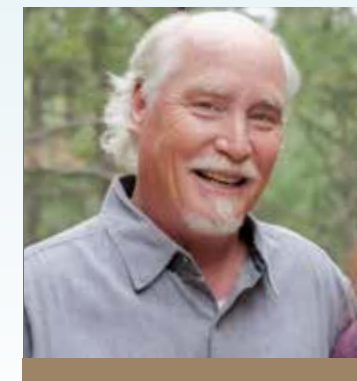
DANIELLE STRICKLAND

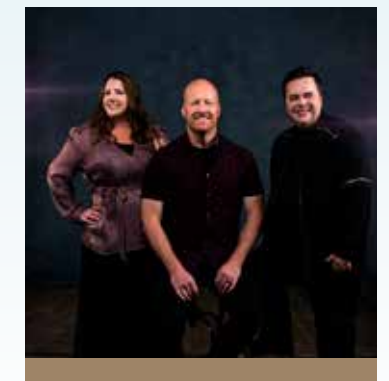
JAMES E. WARD JR.
